STRATEGIC INSTRUCTION MODEL (SIM) CONTENT ENHANCEMENT POTENTIAL PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPER INSTITUTE (PPDI)

The SIM Content Enhancement Potential Professional Developer Institute is a five-day professional development institute that will use the Content Literacy Continuum as the unifying framework. Participants for the institute will be selected through an application process.

The Content Enhancement Institute will prepare educators who have implemented the Content Enhancement Approach to teach other educators to implement Content Enhancement. The Content Enhancement Routines were developed as a part of Strategic Instruction Model to enable educators to teach subject-matter content to diverse classes of learners. Instruction in the use of specific Content Enhancement Routines will not be offered during this week; the focus will be on the professional development process.

Eligible Applicants: (a) are experienced SIM teachers, administrators, coordinators or university personnel who have previously received professional development in Content Enhancement Routines or Learning Strategies and have implemented them successfully with students, (b) have the energy and spirit required to be good professional developers, (c) have effective communication skills in teaching adults and working with administrators, and, most critically (d) have administrative support for their participation in acquiring professional development/instruction, attending update sessions to maintain their professional developer status, finding time and resources required to deliver instruction to others, and gaining wide-spread, long-term implementation success.

There is no registration fee for the Florida Potential SIM Professional Developers' Institutes for Florida educators and includes all professional development materials. Participants must purchase (at their own expense) a one-year subscription to **STRATEWORKS**, a service for SIM Network Professional Developers. Professional development materials include resources necessary for preparing and delivering professional development in the Strategic Instruction Model.

The Strategic Instruction Model (SIM) has been developed and validated over the past 25 years and was developed to assist learning disabled and low achieving adolescents and young adults to meet the demands of educational, community, and employment settings.

APPLICATION PROCESS & DIRECTIONS

POTENTIAL SIM CONTENT ENHANCEMENT PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPERS' INSTITUTE

Step 1

Review and complete the *Application Checklist* (page 3) to ensure that all necessary items are included when submitting your application portfolio. Applicants should include a copy of the checklist with their application materials as well as keep a copy for their own records.

Step 2

Review the *Checklist of Requirements* (page 4) to become a SIM Content Enhancement Professional Developer. Applicants <u>do not</u> need to do anything with this checklist other than be aware of the expectations for completing their certification.

Step 3

Review the *Requirements for Active SIM Profesional Developer/Sponsor/Mentor* (page 5). Each person attending the SIM Content Enhancement (CE) PPDI sesion will need to be sponsored by an existing SIM CE Professional Developer who will work with them to help him or her meet requirements and act as a mentor.

Step 4

Create and submit a Content Enhancement portfolio following the *Directions for Portfolio Contents* (page 6).

Step 5

Review the *Directions for Video Recording* (page 7). Prepare and submit a video (about 20 minutes in length) of yourself using the Cue-Do-Review instructional sequence while teaching using a Content Enhancement device. Applicants <u>do not</u> need to submit the *Cue-Do-Review Checklist* (page 8). This is for your own reflection and will be used when evaluating your video.

Step 6

Complete the *Application for the SIM CONTENT ENHANCEMENT (CE) Potentional Professional Developers' Institute* (pages 9-11). Respond to each of the items as completely and specifically as possible. Additional pages may be added to the application when space to answer questions is inadequate.

Additional Information

REQUIREMENTS FOR ACTIVE SIM PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPER/SPONSOR/MENTOR

Each person attending this session will need to be sponsored by an existing SIM Content Enhancement Professional Developer who will work with them to help him or her meet requirements and act as a mentor. Often the sponsor/mentor is the SIM Professional Developer who instructed the individual in specific Content Enhancement Routines.

- The sponsor/mentor must be a certified SIM Professional Developer who has an active status within the SIM Network.
- The sponsor/mentor must be willing and able to assist the candidate in meeting post-institute requirements.

The sponsor/mentor has the following responsibilities:

- Nominate the candidate for the role of Potential Content Enhancement Professional Developer by writing a letter of support indicating the candidate has been observed and is using the CE Routines successfully.
 - Verify that the candidate has the energy and spirit required of a good Professional Developer
 - Verify that the candidate has communication skills that would be effective in teaching adults
- Co-plan/teach CE professional development sessions with the candidate after the Potential CE Professional Developers' Institute.
- Evaluate the candidate's planning, teaching, and follow-up skills related to CE institutes at least twice during the year following the initial Professional Developers' institute:
- Review the candidate's portfolio, and when the candidate has met all CE Professional Developer requirements, submit the portfolio with the sponsor's written evaluations and recommendations for approval as a CE Professional Developer to the FDLRS Administration Project for recommendation of certification.

DIRECTIONS FOR PORTFOLIO CONTENTS

Submit a portfolio which includes:

- Teacher-generated copies of a minimum of one Unit Organizer and a minimum of one Concept Diagram.
- Two devices constructed by students in their own handwriting for each of at least two of the suggested Content Enhancement Routines (Unit Organizer and Concept). Copies of the devices do not need to be student originals.
 - o Unit Organizer
 - Concept Mastery
 - Concept Anchoring
 - o Concept Comparison
- Evidence such as the course syllabus, a journal, or a letter explaining implementation that, together with the devices, shows course-wide implementation of Content Enhancement Routines and development of a strategic classroom.
- One video recording of the applicant using the Cue-Do-Review instructional steps in a classroom.
- Two letters of support as directed in the following paragraphs.
 - One letter must be from the applicant's employer/administrator and should include information regarding ongoing opportunities the candidate will be given to train others as he/she completes the SIM CE Professional Developer requirements. The employer/administrator should also state the willingness of the district to support the efforts of the Professional Developer to gain widespread, long-term implementation success.
 - The second letter should be written by the certified SIM CE Professional Developer mentor (see Requirements for Active SIM Professional Developer/Sponsor) who has trained the applicant in the Content Enhancement Routines and may have observed the teacher using the Content Enhancement Routines with students successfully. The certified SIM CE Professional Developer should address the experiences that the Professional Developer has had in instruction and observing the applicant and the energy, spirit, and communication skills that this applicant has to help him/her to become an effective Professional Developer in teaching adults. In the letter, the SIM Professional Developer should provide a commitment to "sponsor" the CE Potential Professional Developer and to assist the individual in meeting post-institute Professional Developer requirements.

DIRECTIONS FOR VIDEO RECORDING

The Cue-Do-Review instructional sequence is included in each Content Enhancement Guidebook. Being fluent with the sequence and being able to demonstrate your proficiency with it will be important for the teachers that you will instruct when you are a professional developer.

Prepare a video (about 20 minutes in length) of you using the Cue-Do-Review instructional sequence while teaching using a Content Enhancement device. The Content Enhancement Video checklist that follows will guide you.

- 1. Include all of the **Cue behaviors**. This step will require only a few minutes as you name the device, provide the rationale, and set student expectations.
- 2. Include a representation of the **Do behaviors**. This portion of the video should provide us with a snapshot of your use of the Linking Steps with students and how you engage students in coconstruction of the device.
- 3. Include all of the **Review behaviors**. Similar to the Cue Behaviors, this should require a few minutes. Be sure to ask how the device links to or guides learning, lead some review of the content, and remind students to use the device for instruction and assessment.

Be sure that you:

- Explain the purpose of the video to the students. If the students have not been videoed prior to this session, the teacher should explain the purpose of the video. The video will be used to observe the Content Enhancement Routine instruction and not to observe students.
- Place the camera on a tripod or other steady surface. The camera should be focused on the teacher when he/she is actually showing something and on the screen or board if he/she is pointing to text or writing on a screen, if possible. If the applicant does not have access to a classroom of students, an artificial setting may be created and videoed with the applicant teaching a volunteer student.
- Check the video before mailing it. The session should be recorded and saved to a file that can be opened in Windows Media Player, Quick Time Player or should be submitted on a DVD. The recording should be clearly marked with the applicant's name and should include the name of the routine being modeled and any other information about the classroom setting necessary to set the stage for the viewer. Describe the video you are submitting: describe the routine, identify if this is an introduction of new content or review, etc., the setting, students and situation. Provide any information that will help us adequately evaluate your model.
- Send a copy of the device used for your video. When you submit your video, include a copy of the device that you drafted for the lesson. This can count as one of your submitted devices for item B1 of your application portfolio.
- Remember, you do not need to submit your checklist. It is for your own reflection. This is the checklist that will be used for evaluating your video.

The video will be viewed only by FDLRS Administration Project staff and the Florida SIM Professional Development Leader who will teach the PPDI for the purpose of ascertaining Cue-Do-Review proficiency and will be returned to the applicant. The checklist is on the following page.
